Medieval Latin Sermons represents the science of printing at its zenith. Guillelmus Parisiensis. Medieval Theology. Postilla Super Epistolas et Evangelia. Postilla Guillelmi sup Epistolas et evangelia. Basel, Michael Furter. C. 1497-1506.

Medieval Latin Sermons has explicit lessons on the Gospels and the Epistles. Bernhardus (Claraevallensis) Passio domini nostri Jesu christi. Tractatus beati Bernardi de planctu gloriosissime Marie virginis. Basel, Furter. C. 1501.

Medieval Latin Sermons is Illustrated with 43 Woodcuts with some repeated and so the 3 Section Title Pages are the same large Woodcut of the Crucifixion of Christ!

Medieval Latin Sermons is a very early printing of a hugely popular set of lessons on the Gospels and the Epistles composed in the early 13th Century, compiled in the early 15th Century and first printed in the late 15th and early 16th Centuries in many editions.

Medieval Latin Sermons is contemporary German blind-tooled pigskin over wooden boards, worn and wormed; an exactly appropriate binding for Medieval Latin Sermons, just the way one would want it; very clean internally and well-margined.

Medieval Latin Sermons integration of the main text and surrounding commentary and text and images is exceptionally well executed!
